Directions to Event Location at Ft. Sill

Coming in from the North on Hwy 44, just South of Ft. Sill take Hwy 62 (Rogers Lane) west towards Altus, Approximately 2 miles turn on Sheridan Road then North on Sheridan.

Personnel will have to get a pass from the Visitor Control Center, which is located just outside Sheridan Road gate, just off Rogers Lane

Once they have a pass, they will enter the installation through Sheridan Gate, follow Sheridan road around until they get to Geronimo Road

Take a left on Geronimo Road

Take first left onto Macomb Road

Take first right onto McNair Ave.

Just past building 730 (Snow Hall), students will park in a large parking lot

Ft. Sill Pass instructions

All personnel who do not already have a valid DOD ID Card, will have to fill out the Visitor Form, they can do this ahead of time and can email to <u>michael.t.padilla2.civ@mail.mil</u>

We will coordinate those through our Visitor Control Center and have them for issue at Sheridan Gate the day of the event, or can make arraignments to get them back to you.

Those that wait until the day of to get a pass will have to stop at the Visitor Control Center to get a pass the day of the event. If they do not have a pass, they will not be allowed on Post. They will have to allow extra time that morning in order to get a pass.

All personnel will have to fill out and sign our Hold Harmless Agreement and bring with them the first day of class. We will have additional forms on hand the day of.

Law Enforcement has suggested that everyone use Sheridan Gate, for ease of Access to the installation.

Sheridan Gate is off of Rogers Lane.
